Abstract:

The Open Water Foundation (OWF) is working with the Colorado Water Institute (CWI) at Colorado State University to bring the value of Colorado's Decision Support Systems (CDSS) to universities in Colorado. CDSS provides a wealth of useful information about water resources in Colorado, including databases, websites, GIS layers, documents on water projects, and model data sets. This project seeks to overcome barriers to universities in using CDSS for education and research, and also seeks to foster collaboration so that university research can be integrated into CDSS. This project will pave the way for greater use of CDSS at universities, which will help educate the next generation of water resources engineers.
