

Open Water Foundation (OWF) Board of Directors Position Description

Title:

Board Member (the OWF Board consists of 5 members)

Term: Typically 2 calendar years, shorter if filling an incomplete term

Responsible to: Entire Board, report to Board President

Duties & Responsibilities:

- 1. Is a member of the Board, and has the opportunity to serve in a Board officer position.
- 2. Builds collegial working relationship that contributes to open discussions and consensus.
- 3. Prepares for and regularly attends (or calls in to) Board meetings and related events.
- 4. Provides governance by helping OWF establish and monitor policies, programs, and initiatives.
- 5. Supports development and effectiveness of the Board of Directors and staff.
- 6. Establishes strategic purpose and direction for OWF by participating in strategic planning sessions, contributes to strategic planning documents, and monitoring performance toward plan results.
- 7. Oversees the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and monitors performance of CEO's general responsibilities and yearly objectives.
- 8. Oversees fundraising and business development by advocating for OWF.
- 9. Represents OWF and its initiatives, projects and services to stakeholders, including community, funders and clients.
- 10. Provides direction to ensure the financial health of the OWF through conformance to up-to-date fiscal policies and procedures and through ongoing analysis of financial reports.
- 11. Oversees effective performance of OWF's initiatives and projects through ongoing program planning and evaluation.
- 12. Oversees conformance to federal, state, local and OWF policies and procedures.
